

## **Community Health Assessment: County Snapshot**



# Moving Toward a Healthier Barnwell County

Based on the 2018 County Health Rankings, Barnwell County is ranked 30th out of 46 counties in South Carolina for health outcomes, which measures length and quality of life, and is ranked 36th for health factors, which measures health behaviors, clinical care, social and economic factors, and physical environment.














